*We will be having a PROP donation table set up between the infant classrooms. Please bring a food donation to share with a family in need.

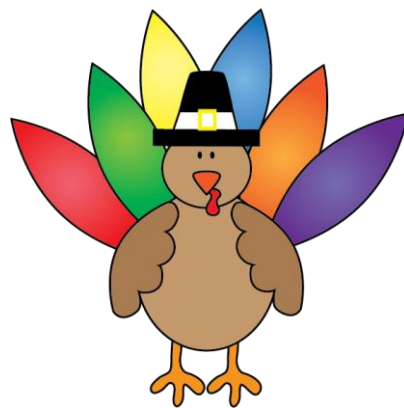
