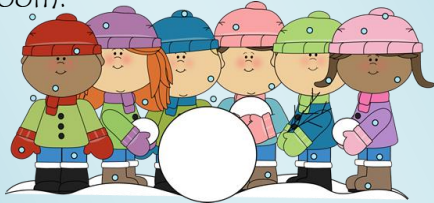


JANUARY NEWSLETTER
